 - The Driver Meeting will serve as an official "initial verbal warning" since everything discussed in the Driver Meeting can be considered an official Q&A response and will be enforced as such.

- **Compliance with Rule <G4> and Participant Release Forms**
 - <G4.b> - students who earned the invite must be the students on the team.
 - <G2> Student Centered (No adult interaction with building/strategy & match play/ within roped off areas)

- **Team Check In starts the day before. - send ONE Coach**

 - STEP ONE: Pre Check in before VEX Worlds on Robotevents.com
 - STEP TWO:
 - Early Check In (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED): [12pm - 6pm day before your event in Hall B](#) (Pits not open), **OR**
 - Additional Check-In: 8am - 11 am the 1st day of the event (Pits are open)
 - Teams will receive their [bracelets](#), participation medals, [dome tickets](#), and [parking pass](#) at check-in
 - [Spectator Check-In](#) begins April 21 on RobotEvents
- **First Aid**
 - Arena First Aid Room is located on the second level concourse of the Arena
 - B, C and D Area First Aid Room located in the first level C area next to meeting room C150
 - E and F Area First Aid Room located by the practice fields in Lobby F in the front of F Exhibit Hall
 - Medical staff will be stationed in Room D221 for medical assistance
- **Required Firmware Updates**
 - Updated firmware and team numbers are required to access the practice and skills fields. Teams must ensure both their controller and robot are running the latest VEXos firmware:
 - V5RC, VEX U, and JROTC Teams - 1.1.2 or later
 - VIQRC 1st Generation Brains - 2.2.1
 - VIQRC 2nd Generation Brains - 1.0.8
- **Inspection**
 - Will be in your Division.
 - **Must be completed by 12pm on the first day of your event.**

- **Skills Participation Process**
 - Keep a close eye on times.
 - You must have your robot in line: only official team members, must have robots & controller to hold a spot in line,
 - Teams may use one Fastpass (if applicable) per skills run
 - Up to 30 minutes before the listed time, the door will close and is final. Doors will close and no one will be permitted inside.
 - Plan your Participation in Skills based on your match schedule.

- **Volunteering**

- **Divisions**
 - Be on time/early - queue minimum of 6 matches ahead
 - Be efficient at loading on and off the field. Be ready to play on the field.
 - Must be in drivers station to discuss scoring and ruling
 - <T.3> Referee calls are final
 - [Safety Glasses are required](#) at the field and in queue for VEX V5 Robotics Competition and VEX U Teams

- **Pit Information**
 - Pit is 8'X8'
 - No Floating Balloons
 - Do not move stanchions or pipe and drape even if you have teams in adjacent pits. It's a safety issue.
 - Each Pit includes one power drop per Team.
 - Teams must remain in their Assigned Pits.
 - Fields can not stick out of your pit.
 - Chairs and tables, and other belongings need to remain inside the 8'x8' area of the pits **at all times**
 - Decorations and Giveaways are encouraged, please do not use pins to hang items.
 - Make sure your Pit Sign is visible at all times so Judges, Volunteers, and other Teams can find you! We encourage you to to keep at the **end** of your event - but please leave the hooks.
- **Teams Must Clear Pits Before Closing Ceremonies**
 - All teams must pack and remove all items from pit areas before closing ceremonies
 - There is dedicated & monitored space to store equipment during the finals (V5RC, JROTC and VEX U Teams - Hall B and VIQRC Teams - Ballroom A)
 - This requirement will allow our staff to begin getting the pit areas ready for the next competition
