

Elements of a Check



Elements of a Check

1. Your checks will come with your name and address already printed in this area. This way the person you are writing the check to will know who it is from.

2. Who are you writing this check to? You will need to write the whole store or person's name on this line. Do not leave this line blank or anyone will be able to cash your check.

3. How much are you writing this check for? You will need to write this number in dollars and cents. Example: 24.50

4. You will need to put the date in which you write the check in this box.

5. Each check has it's own number. The check number will already be printed on your checks when you receive them. All check numbers will be in chronological order 100, 101, 102 etc.

6. Write the dollar amount owed in letter form on this line. If you owe \$25.50 you will need to write it in words like this, Twenty Five dollars and 50 cents or Twenty Five and 50/100.

7. This is your memo area. You need to write what it is that you are paying for. This way you will remember what you spent your money on.

8. Your bank routing number, account number and the check number are in this area. Your bank needs this to know where to remove the money from.

9. You will sign your signature on this line. Be sure to use both your first and last name.

Check Writing Practice


